NORTHERN CHAPTER H.O.G. - Business Meeting - June 21, 2005

Location: City Limits - Called to order by Bob Oliverius at 7pm - Recorded by Kris Cole (Secretary)

Bob Oliverius: (Director): Pig Roast is this Saturday, June 25 at 3pm. Riders can meet at Classic at 10 am for a day ride before the roast. Thursday night this week will be Road Captains choice. Initially the Pig Roast was scheduled for this Thursday but was moved to Saturday. Discussion about future rides. Suggestions tossed out included Roadhouse, Crystal Palace, Buck Snort Saloon, Sugarfoot Saloon. If you would like to take your motor home to West Branch please contact Don Pishney for permit to park at the dealer site for no charge. If you are going to West Branch we would love to have you carry the Chapter Flag. Contact Bob Oliverius. Sturgis: Rick Steele has a 4-bike trailer. If you can pull it he has room for 3 other bikes. If interested contact Bob Oliverius. Canadian National H.O.G. Rally follows Sturgis. Bob has flyer.

FATHER FRED UPDATES: Had a meeting with the Sheriff and Police Departments. They are committed to providing manpower. They feel very strongly this is a tradition in Traverse that the community supports and wants to see continued. They have several requests. (1) 3x5 cards with route printed and laminated to provide to officers. (2) Safety announcement prior to the ride. Helmets are mandatory and tickets will be issued for noncompliance with state law. (3) Riders are to stagger not ride side by side. Officers ride to the left and must be able to move into the procession quickly. Don Pishney will print up the route cards and make a flyer with the safety announcements to be passed out. Will make announcement over PA system before ride. This year the PA System is different and should be clearer and project better than in previous years. Discussed the involvement of **Wild Pigs** club from Detroit with law enforcement. This group of Harley Riders is made up of law enforcement riders. At some point in the past, they provided the security for the Father Fred as local law enforcement had not been asked to participate. We have developed into a community event and now have support of our local Departments. Police Department will address this with the Wild Pigs. The Chapter is requesting the group register for the ride, sign waivers, and we look forward to their continued support of this fundraiser. **DON PISHNEY EXTENDS CONGRATULATIONS AND A HUGE THANK YOU TO BOB OLIVERIUS FOR ALL OF HIS HARD WORK IN PLANNING OF THIS EVENT.**
