**STEVE'S SAFETY CORNER**

On a recent trip to Borders, I ran across a book by David L Hough called **Proficient Motorcycling: The Ultimate Guide to Riding Well**. This is one of the best books on riding I have seen. It covers a lot of territory for the novice and seasoned riders alike. Who says an old dog can't learn new tricks? A good deal of the information I will be passing on to you will be from this publication. There are several sources I draw from, but this one is very comprehensive. If you happen to see it somewhere, take a moment to check it out. This month, we are going to touch on passenger safety. We are responsible for providing a safe environment for our passengers. We need to coach our novice passengers on gear, apparel, communication and body language. The best survival tools we have are knowledge and skill and the ability to provide a safe environment for our passengers. To mount, a passenger should stand up on the left foot peg with hands on the rider's shoulders and swing the right leg over to the foot peg while lowering into the saddle. Once riding, the passenger should move hands to the riders waist as keeping hands on shoulders will push the rider to one side or the other. In braking, consider what happens during hard stops. With a passenger you can expect longer stopping distances due to the additional weight (don't rub this in) and the additional weight over the rear axle will change the way your bike stops. During a quick stop with a passenger, that person will be more than likely all over your back side. If you regularly carry a passenger, try a few quick stops to get acquainted. When cornering, remember that the geometry of the bike has changed. The added weight will compress your rear suspension and reduce your clearance for cornering. You will need a larger turning radius or slower speeds through a corner. Tires generally need a few more pounds of air. On a downhill, more weight is shifted to the front wheel. Here you have both the energy of the engine and gravity pulling you downhill so give some extra braking distance before the curve. On an uphill, the passengers weight (here we go again) is positioned behind the rear axle so the front end becomes very light and traction is decreased. This causes the front end to want to drift wide. Keeping the forward energy steady will help pull uphill at a steady pace and keep better control. Most of us have given rides to younger passengers. Kids love motorcycles! The greatest danger we face with our younger passengers is the possibility of them falling off. Most kids I have known that ride have a tendency to fall asleep on the back after the initial excitement of the ride is diminished. Giving kids something to hold on to is great while they are awake and able to hold on, but falling asleep poses a danger most of us don't want to consider. Strapping them to us or the seat has its own dangers, especially if the bike goes down ... they go with us or the bike. Either way has the potential for injury. Next month we'll be revisiting an old friend...hand signals, including my personal favorite. Until then, be safe. Steve
